## Joy to the World

Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things. -- Psalm 98

There are striking similarities in thought and expression between the Magnificat and the 98th Psalm. The Psalms which celebrate the kingship of Yahweh are called "Coronation Psalms." In these hymns of praise, Yahweh is portrayed as King of Israel. Israel constantly remembered that no matter who sat on the temporal throne, Yahweh, the LORD, was the true king.

So too, Mary proclaims her hymn in celebration of the kingship of God when she says, "My soul <u>proclaims</u> the greatness of the LORD; my spirit rejoices in God my savior." And we too sing our hymn in celebrating God's kingship over the universe, 'Joy to the world, the Lord has come; let earth receive her king."

I continue to wonder about this marvel of God becoming human. He who is great became small; he who is powerful became weak; he who is rich became poor, he who is divine became human .

Should not our attitude be one of gratitude ---- gratitude to the God who gave us salvation through his Son? In becoming our brother, he called us to serve and follow him as servants of his servants. We can then sing our song with new verses, in celebration of the Christ Child's advent in another way:

Joy to the world in our vow of poverty, joy to the world in our vow of chastity; joy to the world in our vow of obedience; that by our life and worship we may glorify God.

May God's love given in the Christ Child be a light to all <u>humanity</u>, and peace to each of you. □
